- 4. Chamber Director Report: Bri reported that the Chamber was approved for Canva Pro Free for Nonprofits! She will begin working to design a class for Chamber Members to attend on how to use Canva. A survey was also sent out to all the Chamber over the Parade of Lights. It had a great response and will be a valuable resource in the planning of the 2021 event. A couple of businesses have offered to provide promotional items to fill the "New to Neligh" bags. Lastly, the city crew has offered to try to remove the Christmas decorations for the Chamber this year, weather pending. We are incredibly appreciative of their help and efforts to take advantage of the nicer weather!
- 5. ED Report: Lauren reported that there are still Covid-19 emergency grants still available. There are also funds available for Digital Façade Grants where a business can use the funds for a website, marketing, upgrading or purchasing a POS system, cameras for their digital marketing, and so many more option. At the January Council meeting, it will also be reviewed to approve the first electric incentive for a new business and to approve a LB840 loan to a starting business.

Lauren was asked to speak to legislature in the upcoming month on why to keep microenterprise tax credits around. She will be preparing for that. On the Clearwater side of things, she has been busy getting the strategic plan created. Our office was also contacted by the new Scarlet Marriott Hotel in Lincoln with them asking to have facts, photos, and information on Neligh to name a room after the town of Neligh.
